3.0 Circulation

3.1 Registration

- A. Purpose: To provide a means by which library services can be easily accessed and to define the various conditions under which library cards are issued.
- B. All new registrations are restricted to a two-item checkout limit for first time use.
- C. Supervisors may authorize exceptions to the policy outlined below.
- D. All residents of New Hanover County are eligible for a free public library card that enables the check-out of library materials and access to other library services. Cards are valid for 3 years and can be renewed if there are no fees, blocks or excessive fines attached to the customer record.
